

## AESTHETIC PREPARATION CHECKLIST

01	PRE PREP CHECKLIST  Check pre-op photos, retake any shots as needed.  Review patient goals and expectations, shade selection and photos of desired shade
02	DIAGNOSTIC TRANSFER (IF NOT DIAGNOSTIC WAX UP - SEE MOCK UP BELOW*)  Evaluate models determine if any immediate gross enameloplasty is required.  • Minor contouring of existing teeth  Two Stage Matrix Overlay Technique  • Fit clear essix reduction in patient's mouth / Verify passive seat  • Fill two stage matrix /Bisacrylic Provisional Material & place over teeth  • Verify lengths of all units by measuring wax up vs. intra-oral transfer, overbite, and overjet relationships / Verify complete seat.  Anesthetize  Major contouring & shaping of overlay teeth (arch form, incisal length, etc.)  Gingivectomy (if needed- marked in red pencil on wax up)  Measure the length of centrals from final gingival margin & record on RX  Make 2 Impressions of final look only if diagnostic transfer has been altered):  • One for Temps and one to keep in office if temporaries need to be remade or repaired.  Mock Up (Please call account specialist if more detail needed  • In flowable composite, establish incisal edge position of 8 & 9, midline, buccal corridor  • Take impression or scan and photographs.
03	Preparation of teeth using depth guides Veneers 0.6mm Full Coverage Crowns 1.5mm Evaluate incisal clearance for translucency requests More than 2 shades lighter requires 1.0mm reduction  Evaluate preps; No sharp line angles, rounded edges, axial inclination of preps pointing to the belly button, clearance utilizing triad guides, preps should have slight taper to incisal/occlusal edges, uniform prep reduction of all teeth  Pick prep shades. Cervical and Body. Take photos for lab with tabs in photos.  Stick-Bite Registration. Take photo for Lab.  Impressions of each arch.  Use full arch trays + adhesive or scans (no sub g prep or veneer preps for best results)  Take Futar D tripod segment bite (with edentulous in posterior need putty transfer)
04	PROVISIONALS  Fabricate provisionals with bisacryl (be sure to remove all excess flash)  Finalize the provisionals  Lengths and shapes and measurements  Margins and embrasures  Occlusion (untreated teeth must have no bisacryl on them)  Take an earless facebow, patient upright and horizontal level  Take a photo of the bow in place  Take an impression of the provisionals (a perfect impression)  Glaze temporaries
