

## **FULL MOUTH REHABILITATION DEPROGRAMMED RECORDS APPOINTMENT CHECKLIST**

As developed by the Clinical Mastery Series protocol, the following is a guideline for taking a deprogrammed bite records for your diagnostic wax up. This appointment in general, follows the delivery of the patient's release appliance and

protocol.

Take composite ball record. Keep patient from closing on back teeth once release appliance is removed. Add composite in between maxillary and mandibular centrals, just enough to keep back teeth from touching.

Determine final vertical dimension of the case. (CEJ to CEJ measure)

- If no vertical change then is this a CO case?
- Full intercuspation for CO
- If change in VDO then it is a CR case.

Take molar bite relationships with Futar D Fast Set

Take tripod bite using new anterior ball at new VDO

Gross Mock Up

- Central Length
- Smile Line
- Midline
- Buccal Corridor

Take Photos of Mock Up

Take Facebow record

Mark on pre-op model tissue reduction or indicate on prescription

Take impression of mockup

Take polyvinyl anterior bite with posterior bites in

Take stick bite with Rigistick

Mock up lower incisors and take impressions

Remove mock up and take necessary pre-op photos.

Complete Wax Up Rx
